Oblong spurge

(Euphorbia oblongata)

Mature Size Waist



Description

- Erect perennial up to 3 ft. tall
- Inconspicuous tiny flower clusters surrounded by yellow petal-like leaves
- Leaves alternate along finely hairy stem, 2-3 in. long, finely toothed
- Upright stems are red at the base and contain a milky sap





- Seedpods have a waxy appearance
- Reproduces by seed and vegetatively from rhizomes and root fragments
- Spread by roads and horticulture
- Native to Eurasia
