(*Leucanthemum vulgare*)

Mature Size Knee



Description

- Perennial herb with daisy-like flowers up to 40 in. tall
- Flowers grow singly on the end of each blooming stem with white petals, 1-2 in.



long with yellow centers

- Spoon-shaped, irregularly toothed leaves
- Reproduces by seed and from rhizomes
- Spread by roadsides and horticulture
- Native to Europe

Bloom Period Jun - Aug

Habitat Wetland, grassland, scrub
